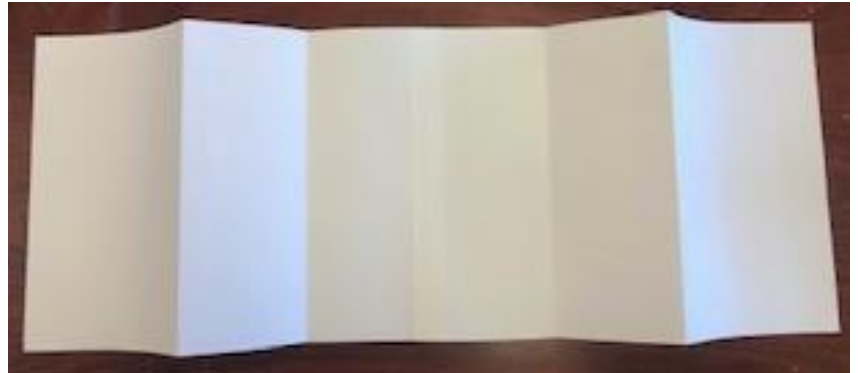


PDF Teacher Guide: 'Where the Forest Meets the Sea' collage. 2H

Inspired by Jeannie Baker's book and art from the book 'Where the Forest Meets the Sea'.

1. Stick two pieces of art paper together and fold to create a foldout paper (shown below).



2. Have students close the paper and draw a picture of the natural part of the Daintree Rainforest, from the beginning of the book 'Where the Forest Meets the Sea'.



3. Students then drew this image again on the inside of the paper and painted all the sand in yellow, water and sky in blue and added a little bit of grey to the sky in the middle.



4. Once all painted, students used various recycled materials and crêpe paper to stick over the paint surfaces to show the natural environment on the outside and the built environment on the inside. Students also drew items and buildings using pencil on paper and cut and pasted it onto the centre section of the artwork.





During this step, students used the Jeannie Baker image (below) located at the end of the book for inspiration.



5. If necessary, teacher can stick some cardboard to back of the artworks to allow them to stand alone/ be displayed on a table.
